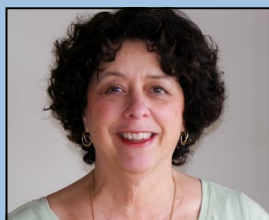

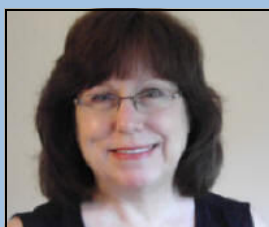
We are proud to be able to bring you some of the world's foremost authorities on Prader-Willi Syndrome including:



Dr Suzanne Cassidy (USA) - Medical Geneticist

Dr Cassidy has been a prominent figure in the PWS community for over two decades. She has been on the faculty of several universities and is currently Clinical Professor of Paediatrics at the University of California, Irvine. She has published dozens of medical articles and book chapters on PWS spanning genetics, medical aspects, behaviour and management, and has conducted multidisciplinary clinics for PWS since 1982.

She was a major organizer of several IPWSO meetings, including the first, and has been on the Scientific Advisory Board of PWSA (USA) for many years. Dr Cassidy is the current President of the International PWS Organisation.



Janice Forster (USA) - Child and Adolescent Psychiatrist

Janice Forster is a Child and Adolescent Psychiatrist in private practice in Pittsburgh, PA who specializes in Developmental Neuropsychiatry. In addition to her clinical experience in the evaluation and treatment of individuals with developmental disabilities, she has acquired specific expertise in the management of individuals with PWS across all levels of care.

She is a consultant to the Prader-Willi Syndrome Association of the USA where she serves on the Clinical Advisory Board and a consultant to IPWSO where she serves on the Scientific Advisory Committee.
